Evaluate your lifestyle and be accountable to leadership in your local church about your **development**.

You need **Godly authority** in your life to stand in Christ with victory, set free to **live the dream** Father God has for you. Godly authority with excellence can only be established **through** the **Word of God** in every ministry and it is very important in order to **fulfil** your **calling** and achieve the **goals** that God has for you.

- **Declare** how **excellent** His Name is in all the earth. (Ps. 8:1)
- **Approve** (discern, show forth) the things that are **excellent**. (Phil. 1:10b)
- **Show** the more **excellent way** (love). (1 Cor. 12:31)
- **Develop excellent** speech. (Prov. 17:7)
- **Exercise** your faith to develop **excellence**. (2 Pet. 1:6)
- **Allow** the process for God to make you an eternal **excellence**. (Is. 60:15)
- **Meditate** on... what is **excellent**. (Phil. 4:8)
- **Sing** to the Lord for He has done **excellent** things. (Is. 12:5)
- **Believe** that you as saints are the “**excellent ones**”. (Ps. 16:3)

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To be a servant is not a curse and it is not about slavery, but it is an expression of respect and pure love to proclaim, in a practical way, the priorities of your life, from your heart. **Your attitude should be the same as that of My Son, Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with Me, something to be grasped, but made Himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.** (from Phil 2:5-7)

You say that you serve My Son, and if it is true, the fruit will be seen in how you serve others. My Son is so intensely aware of the need in the nations. When you are found to be a faithful servant, it will be said about you: ...

- **"For My Son was hungry, and you gave Him something to eat,**
- **My Son was thirsty and you gave Him something to drink,**
- **My Son was a stranger and you invited Him in,**
- **My Son needed clothes and you clothed Him,**
- **My Son was sick and you looked after Him,**
- **My Son was in prison and you came to visit Him."**

(from Matt. 25:35,36)

Your motivation as a servant must be to do everything as if unto the Lord. **My Son, the King, will reply: "I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of Mine, you did for Me."**

(from Matt 25:40)

You have the privilege, not only to serve, but also to follow the example of the Servant of all, My Son, Jesus Christ. ... **whoever wants to be first must be your slave, just as My Son did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.** (from Matt 20:27-28)

Do not be discouraged when you sometimes struggle to know how you should serve with the strength, guidance, help and wisdom available to you. My Son opened the way for you to have a fresh start every day, even if you feel you cannot deal with the thoughts of condemnation. **How much more, then, will the blood of Jesus Christ, My Son, who through the eternal Spirit, offered Himself unblemished to Me, cleanse your consciences from acts that lead to death, so that you may serve Me, the living God!** (from Heb 9:14)

You are a masterpiece, created by Me in such a way that you will always have the capacity to do the works I have prepared for you. Take time to hear My agenda every day. **For you are My workmanship, created in Christ Jesus, My Son, to do good works, which I have prepared in advance for you to do.** (from Eph. 2:10)

He will help you and He will always be there for you. Remain focused on Him. **Whoever serves My Son, Jesus, must follow Him; and where He is, His servant will also be. I will honor the one who serves Him.** (from John 12:26)

- **Jesus was a stranger and you invited Him in,**
- **Jesus needed clothes and you clothed Him,**
- **Jesus was sick and you looked after Him,**
- **Jesus was in prison and you came to visit Him.”**

(from Matt. 25:35,36)

My motivation as a servant must be to do everything I do as if unto the Lord. If that is my perspective, **the King will reply to me and say: “I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of Mine, you did for Me.”** (from Matt 25:40)

I have the privilege to serve but I need to understand how to follow the example of Jesus. He is the “Servant of all,” and He said that **if I want to be first, I must be my brother's slave, just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.** (from Matt. 20:27,28)

I choose not to be discouraged when I sometimes struggle to know how I should serve with the strength, guidance, help and wisdom available to me. Jesus opened the way for a fresh start every day, even if I feel I cannot deal

with the thoughts of condemnation. **How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit, offered Himself unblemished to God, cleanse my conscience from acts that lead to death, so that I may serve the living God!** (from Heb. 9:14)

I can work diligently and have an excellent life with God, but as I become familiar with success, I need to allow humility to protect me and remember that it is all because of His grace. **So I also, when I have done everything I have been told to do, I should say, "I am an unworthy servant. I have**

**only        done        my        duty.”** (from Luke 17:10)

I will worship the Father in Spirit and Truth, in all that I say, sing and do, and then my heart will be safe with Him. **Whatever I do, I must work at it with all my heart as working for the Lord, not for men. It is the Lord Jesus Christ I am serving!** (from Col. 3:23,24b)

## 4. TRUTH'S conversation with me about ...

### SERVANTHOOD

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Christ set us an example of how to be a servant with excellence. The Word says: **“Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness.”** (Phil. 2:5-7)

Serving the Lord accurately includes serving my brothers and sisters. In the prophetic teachings of Jesus, He speaks of eternal life and eternal punishment. To the people on His right, who inherit eternal life, He will say:

- **“For I was hungry, and you gave Me something to eat,**
- **I was thirsty and you gave Me something to drink,**
- **I was a stranger and you invited Me in,**
- **I needed clothes and you clothed Me,**
- **I was sick and you looked after Me,**
- **I was in prison and you came to visit Me.”**

(Matt. 25:35,36)

The righteous will ask where and when all of this happened? **The King will reply: “I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of Mine, you did for Me.”** (Matt. 25:40)

When Jesus Christ is your motivation and focus in serving, you will also see how He Himself set the example first. Matt. 20:27,28 declares: **“And whoever wants to be first must be your slave, just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”**

The Lord has a specific task for everybody. Every one of us has a unique specific calling. When we just do as we like, we are busy with acts that lead to death but, through the blood of Jesus, tomorrow can be a new opportunity. This is true according to Heb. 9:14, **“How much more, then,**



**will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!”**

Don't just go to God with your agenda. Hear from Him what He wants you to do, according to His will and plan for your life. Eph. 2:10 explains this principle: **“For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.”**

Many times, we just have to step out in faith, to do according to what we believe God is commanding us to do. But remember the promise Jesus gives us as His servants: **“Whoever serves Me must follow Me; and where I am, My servant will also be. My Father will honour the one who serves Me.”** (John 12:26)

We have the honour and privilege to work with Him. **“For we are God's fellow-workers.”** (1 Cor. 3:9a)

Position and present yourself as a faithful servant, who understands what to do every day. Rom. 12:1,2 says,

**“Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy,**

- **to offer your bodies as living sacrifices,**
- **holy and pleasing to God,**
- **this is your spiritual act of worship.**
- **Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world,**
- **but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.**
- **Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is,**
- **His good, pleasing and perfect will.”**

To do His will with the right attitude will always bring honour to God. In Luke 17:10, Jesus says: **“So you also, when you have done everything you were told to do, should say; ‘We are unworthy servants; we have only done our duty.’”**

To summarise it all in one sentence:

**“Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.”**

(Col. 3:23,24b)
